

Notice of Interment at Uplyme Cemetery



This notice, along with the Registrar's or Coroner's Certificate (or certificate of cremation in the case of ashes), is to be delivered to the Parish Clerk (Mr Ricky Neave, 55 Shearwater Way, Seaton, Devon, EX12 2FT) in conjunction with the payment fee, before any arrangements can be made. Please give at least 48 hours notice. No applications for burials can be received at weekends or on Public Holidays.

Note: The Births and Deaths Registration Act 1926 requires that before burials can be effected, the Council must have received a Certificate of the Registrar of Births and Deaths that the death has been registered, or confirmation that he has received notice of the death, or a Coroner’s order for burial. Interments of ashes must be accompanied by a Certificate of Cremation.

I hereby indemnify Uplyme Parish Council against all claims, demands, charges, costs, expenses, actions, liability or losses which the said Council may hereafter suffer by reason of the opening / re-opening of the above grave and interment of the body / cremated remains therein.

(Explanation: if an Exclusive Right of Burial in a grave has been purchased from the Council, the consent of the owner of the exclusive right is needed for the burial of any body or ashes other than that of the owner of the right. The written consent is not necessary when the remains are those of the person whose name is on the deed of grant.)
