

Notes from the Annual Parish and Council Meeting, 11th May 2016

Applications considered by the Planning Committee (see minutes for full details):

- **Harcombe Cross Harcombe Road Axminster EX13 5TB**, Reserved matters application pursuant to application 13/1975/OUT for the erection of a dwelling (matters of layout, scale, access, appearance and landscaping to be considered, *No Objection*)
- **Hunters Croft Charmouth Road Axminster EX13 5ST**, Single storey rear extension Perhams Holcombe Lane Uplyme Lyme Regis DT7 3SN, Change of use of field to provide new access and construction of garage, *No objection*
- **The Halt Venlake Uplyme Lyme Regis Devon DT7 3SE**, Construction of single storey rear extension and balcony, 2no dormers to north elevation, *No objection*
- **White Wings Woodhouse Hill Uplyme Lyme Regis DT7 3SL**, Re-build and extension of garage, construction of outbuilding in front garden, *No objection*
- **Perhams Holcombe Lane Uplyme Lyme Regis DT7 3SN**, Change of use of field to provide new access and construction of garage, *Objection*

- **Beech House Woodhouse Lane**, Construction of two storey and single storey side extensions; enlargement of existing porch and construction of detached garage (demolition of conservatory) (extra info Re. trees). *Approved with conditions*
- **Land East Of Redlane Cross Rocombe**, Erection of temporary agricultural workers' dwelling and poultry unit. *Withdrawn*

- Almost completed the Neighbourhood Plan and would like to thank everyone concerned for all their hard work
- The church grave yard is still under debate on whether we take on the maintenance or hand it over to EDDC.

Councillor Chris James was elected unanimously as Chairman and Councillor John Duffin was elected as Vice Chairman.

Councillor John Garland has stepped down as Chairman but will continue his role as councillor until he leaves in June, fellow councillors and the public thanked John for his dedication and hard work on behalf of Uplyme.
