

## MONUMENTS, GRAVESTONES. AND TABLETS

Only a headstone, vase or tablet, which conforms to the dimensions given below, may be placed in the new part of Uplyme Cemetery. Prior approval must be obtained from the Parish Clerk.

Fees for the right to place on a grave or plot in respect of which the Exclusive Right of Burial has been granted:

<b>Fees:</b>	<i>Resi- dent</i>	<i>Non- resident</i>
A headstone or cross, of agreed design, not exceeding 4ft in height and 3ft in width (122 x 91cm)	£132	£264
Inscribed vase (on plinth only) at head of grave, not exceeding 1ft 6in (46cm)	£66	£132
Tablet on cremation plot or grave, not exceeding 1ft 6in (46cm) square, set level with ground	£66	£132

Please inscribe the grave number on reverse of headstones. Further inscriptions on existing monuments do not attract a charge.

If other kinds of monument are required (for example in the old cemetery), contact the Parish Clerk in the first instance to discuss fees.

# Uplyme Parish Council CEMETERY FEES AND CONDITIONS OF USE

Single fees will be charged for: residents of the parish at time of death, people resident elsewhere but paying council tax in the parish at time of death; people who move from Uplyme to a hospice or nursing home with a terminal condition. Discretion will be exercised (by the Clerk in consultation with the Chairman and Vice-Chairman) in the case of long-time residents who move into a care home, but not if moving away to permanent accommodation.

*In all other cases the fees will be doubled.*

Effective from 14<sup>th</sup> December 2016 until further notice.

## INTERMENTS

Interments are only to take place between 9am and 4pm on Monday to Friday and must be notified at least 48 hours beforehand.

The Council does not undertake the digging of graves. The digging, backfilling and reinstatement of graves is the responsibility of the undertakers. Depth of graves not to exceed 6ft (183cm).

Ashes must be interred either in a biodegradable container, or directly into the ground.

Reinstatement includes the requirement, after a period of six months to allow for settlement, that all graves must then be levelled and grass reinstated in a minimum of 4 inches (10cms) of top soil. In the absence of such reinstatement, but not until seven months after the date of interment, the Council will complete the work, without notice, and the cost shall be repaid to the Council by the undertakers.

*Interments in Uplyme Cemetery are allowed only on acceptance of the above conditions.*

## EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS OF BURIAL IN EARTHEN GRAVES

Exclusive Right of Burial is granted for a period of 99 years.
