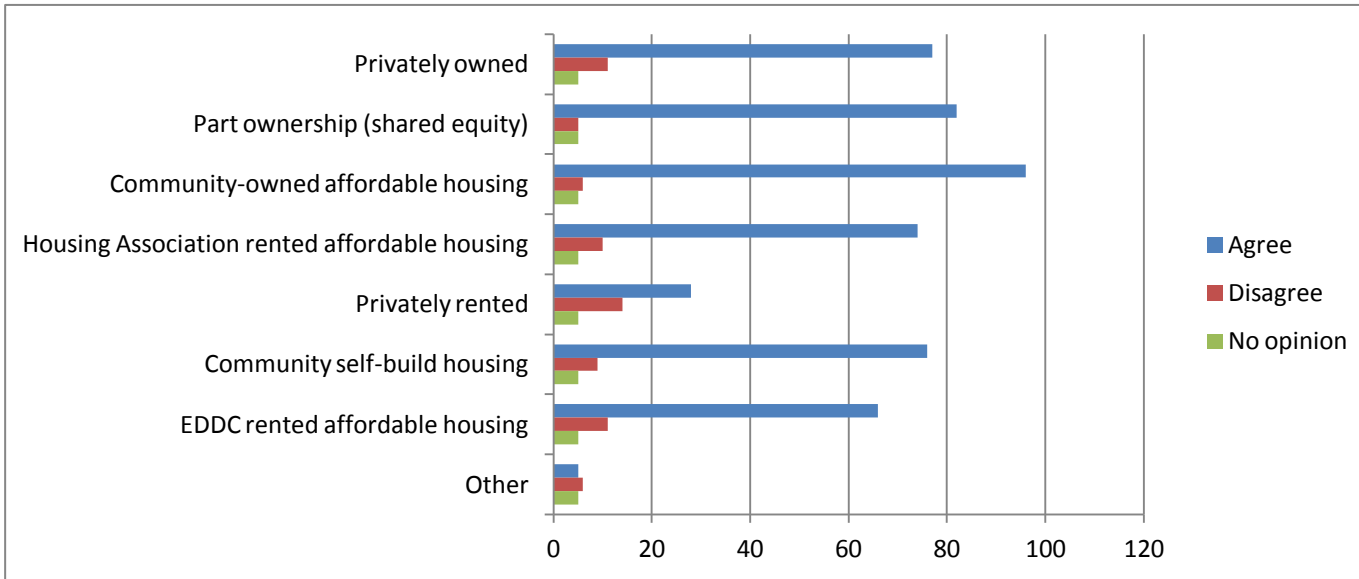
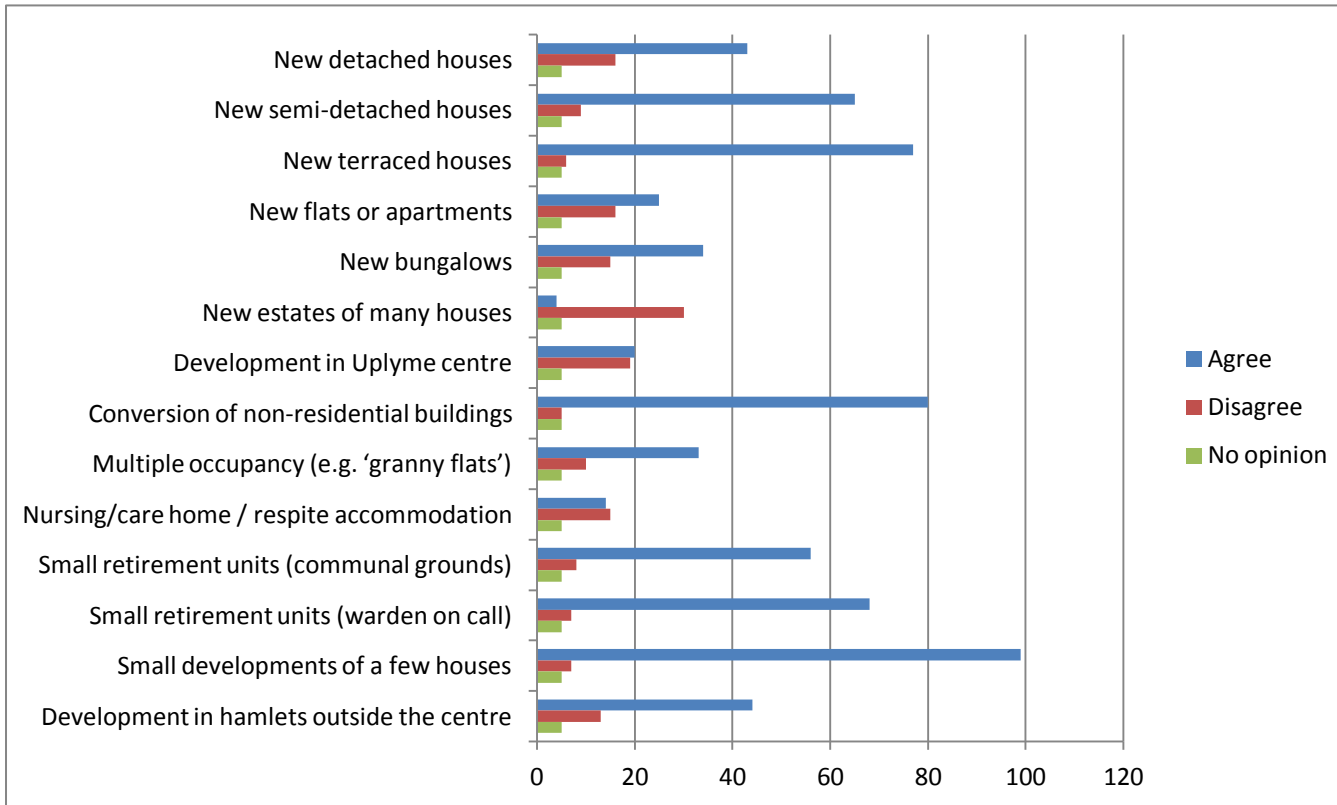


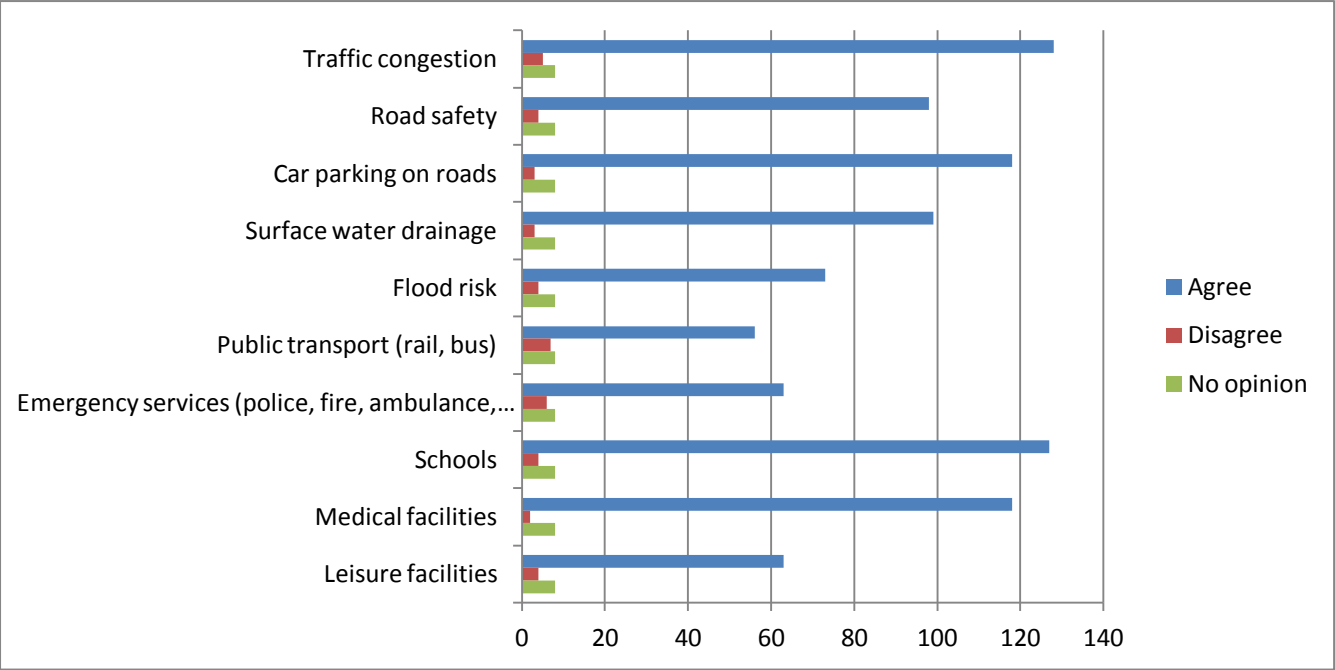
Which of the following types of housing ownership do you think should be encouraged?



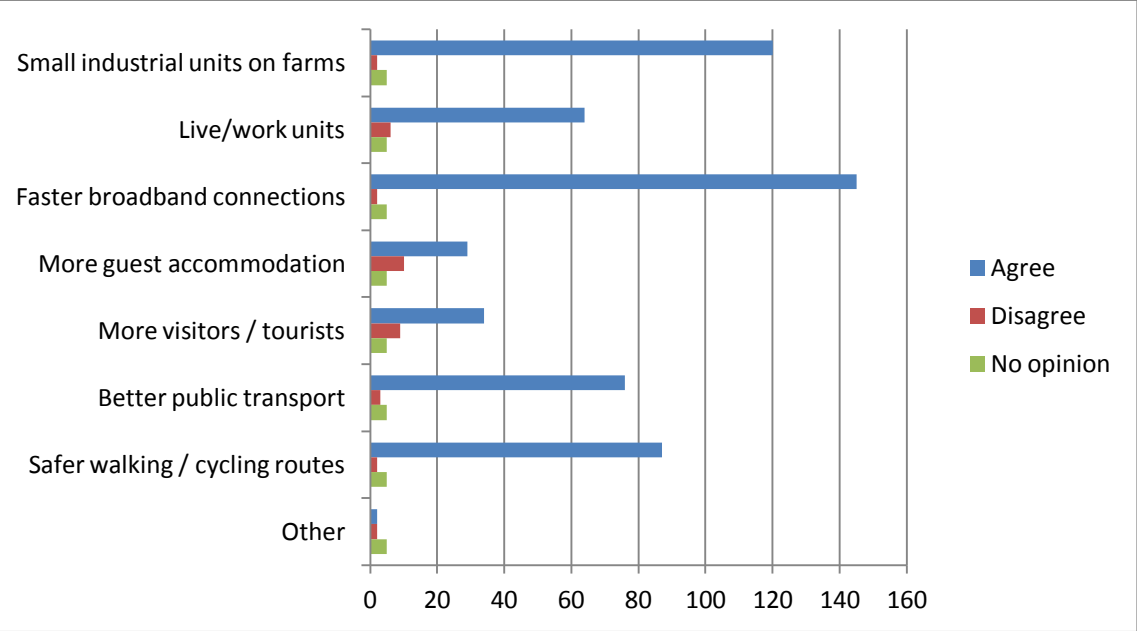

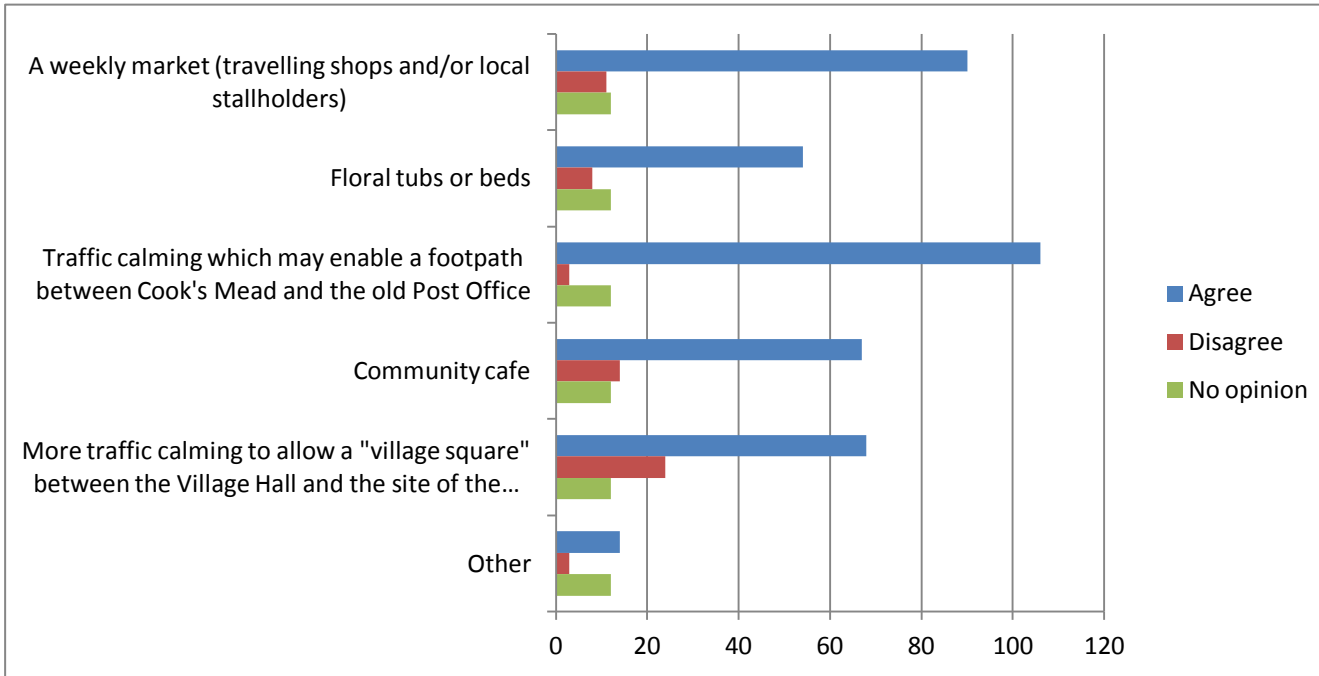

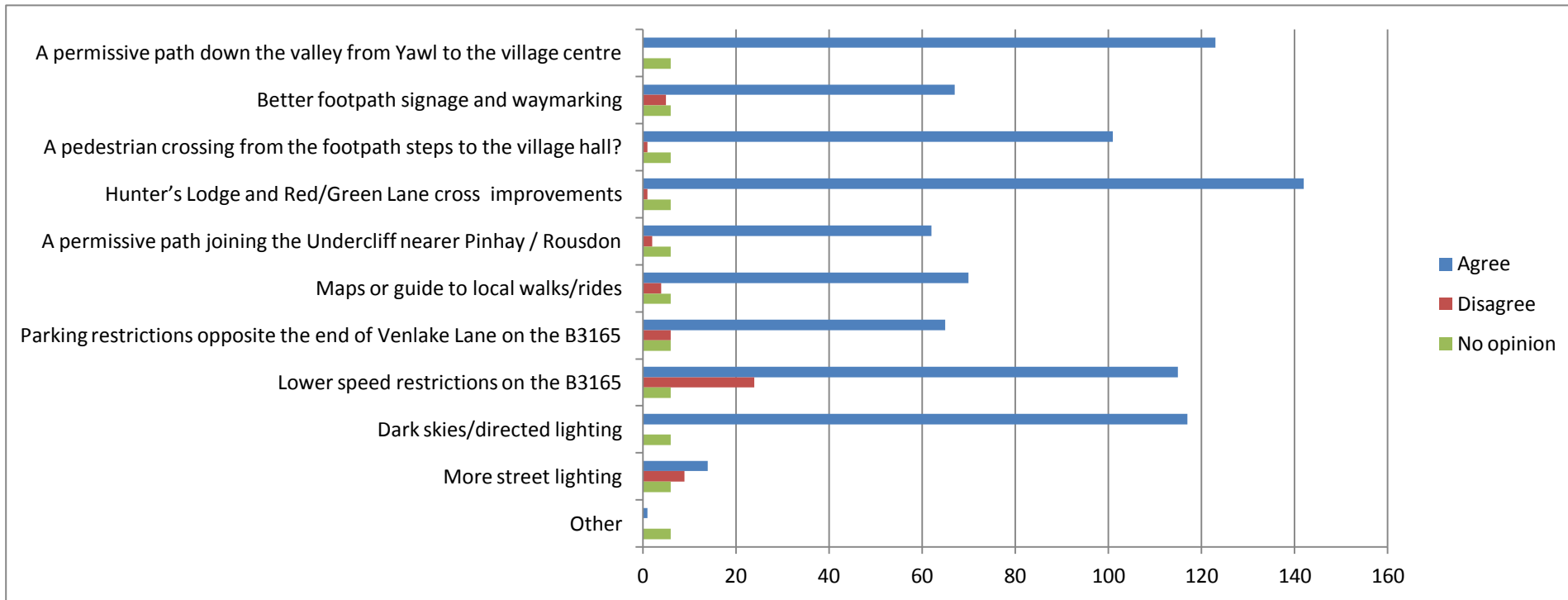
