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**Note:** The Births and Deaths Registration Act 1926 requires that before burials can be effected, the Council must have received a Certificate of the Registrar of Births and Deaths that the death has been registered, or confirmation that he has received notice of the death, or a Coroners order for burial. Interments of ashes must be accompanied by a Certificate of Cremation.
